Level 1 - Foundation Course in Dowsing

Tutored by CSD registered tutor, 1 day teaching + 1 hour on-line group meeting format equating to a minimum 7 hours tuition

Aim

- To give students a comprehensive foundational understanding of dowsing, including philosophy, applications, techniques, ethics and personal protection

Objectives: at the end of the course the students will be able to:

- Understand the nature of dowsing, including its history and uses
- Be able to use basic dowsing tools
- To understand how to dowse for water, health and earth energies
- Appreciate and apply dowsing ethics and psychic protection

Introduction, history and philosophy of dowsing

- Description of the range of uses and practical applications of dowsing.

Use of dowsing tools and techniques

- State of mind required for good dowsing
- Asking clear and concise questions when dowsing
- Use of pendulum, L-rods & other tools
- Different dowsing techniques, including informational dowsing, site dowsing, remote dowsing, map dowsing, the use of witness samples, dowsing without tools

Applied dowsing

- Dowsing for water
- Concealed underground features including archaeological targets
- Dowsing for health & healing including food testing
- Dowsing earth energies
- Dowsing in everyday life

Dowsing ethics & psychic protection

- Consideration of dowsing ethics & the CSD code of ethics
- Issues of psychic protection when dowsing
